







Currently, we are proposing an expansion to extend the life of the mine.

For this, we must do the following:

- Adapt the process plant within our current property.
- **2** Define a material transport system.
- Build a tailings dam, which is a place where material resulting from mining processes with no commercial value is deposited.

To determine the feasibility of the tailings dam construction and define a material transportation system, we need to conduct studies that consider the following:



#### **TECHNICAL ASPECTS:**

To study the geological formation of soils, their stability and safety for the construction of structures.



### **ENVIRONMENTAL ASPECTS:**

To analyze the flora and fauna present in the area, the air quality and water sources of important value. Also, to avoid the intervention of protected areas and the presence of archaeological sites or finds that could be of national interest.



## **SOCIAL ASPECTS:**

To understand nearby populations, their conditions, their livelihoods, and their development needs. Carrying out these feasibility studies will provide us with meaningful data to know if the project is viable and how we could enhance the positive impacts that it would generate for the communities and for the country.









These activities do not include the extraction of gold outside the areas of the current concession, located in the municipal district of Zambrana, municipality of Cotuí, Sánchez Ramírez province.
