

Conflict Minerals Policy

Hyllion Holdings Corp. (“Hyllion”) is committed to sourcing components and materials from companies that share our values regarding respect for human rights, integrity, and environmental responsibility. Hyllion complies with the OECD Due Diligence Guidance for Responsible Supply Chains of Minerals from Conflict-Affected and High-Risk Areas, as well as the applicable requirements of Section 1502 of the Dodd-Frank Act, which aims to prevent the use of minerals that directly or indirectly finance or benefit armed groups in the Democratic Republic of the Congo (DRC) or in adjoining countries.

Hyllion suppliers are required to commit to conducting due diligence on the origin and chain of custody of minerals in accordance with OECD guidance to help ensure that smelters and refiners in their supply chain sourcing minerals from conflict-affected and high-risk areas are either conformant to the Responsible Minerals Assurance Process assessment protocols or are actively working towards becoming conformant.
