
Fiercely Committed to Our Communities

Ameris Bank is fiercely committed to improving the communities we serve. This starts in our branches and offices by offering solutions and guidance that help build financial peace of mind, and it extends beyond our walls through the many important organizations we are proud to partner with.

Community involvement is a part of our culture, as thriving communities benefit everyone. By investing in social and economic initiatives, we create lasting, positive impacts. Supporting local education and healthcare, encouraging teammates to volunteer, and building trust with customers strengthens our relationships and drives long-term value for teammates and shareholders.

Giving with HEART

In 2024, Ameris Bank donated **\$2.23 million to 40 rural hospitals** in Georgia, as part of the Georgia HEART Hospital Program.



Ameris has been participating in the Georgia HEART program since 2018, contributing more than \$12 million.

"Ameris is proud to support our rural hospitals and the communities they serve," said Ameris Bank CEO Palmer Proctor. "The Georgia HEART Hospital Program is important because it not only provides much needed funding to these crucial hospitals, but also allows them to choose how the money is best spent to care for their patients."

Of the 40 hospitals receiving funding, the majority serve communities where Ameris does not have a physical presence, highlighting the bank's commitment to improving healthcare throughout the state. Both 2023 and 2024 have been record-setting years for Georgia HEART donations from Ameris, totaling more than \$4 million.

The Georgia Rural Hospital Tax Credit enables Georgia businesses and taxpayers to redirect their Georgia income tax liability to support qualified hospitals. Participation in the Georgia HEART Hospital Program is limited to Georgia rural hospitals that meet qualification criteria established by law.





Ameris Donates Land to the City of Moultrie

Ameris Bank has donated a significant plot of land to the Downtown Development Authority of the city of Moultrie, Georgia. This contribution represents a major advancement in enhancing the quality of life for Moultrie's residents and attracting more people to the downtown area by transforming the greenspace into a vibrant community park and potentially redeveloping three existing buildings into hospitality, residential or retail spaces.

The donation aligns with Ameris Bank's longstanding commitment to the Moultrie community. By providing this land and its office buildings, Ameris Bank is making an investment in Moultrie's future and demonstrating its dedication to the well-being and prosperity of its residents.

The new park will feature walking paths, playgrounds, and areas designed for both relaxation and recreation. It will be a gathering place for families, a playground for children, and a haven for individuals seeking to enjoy nature's beauty right in the heart of Moultrie.

"Ameris has been a proud member of the Moultrie community for many years, and we are honored to provide this greenspace for generations of residents to enjoy," said Palmer Proctor, CEO of Ameris Bank. "We believe in giving back to the communities we serve, and the donated park and building space will be a lasting legacy that enhances the downtown area and the Moultrie community."



Supporting the Arts

In 2022, Ameris became the first sponsor of the Callanwolde Fine Arts Center's Art Scholars program, a partnership we continued in 2024. This program provides a day of enriching activities for students in Title I schools on multiple school holidays when families would otherwise need to arrange childcare. Children enjoy a day of painting, drawing, creative movement and meals at no cost. In addition to funds, Ameris supplies tote bags, coloring books and art supplies for the students, and the bank's lion mascot, "Courageous," often makes an appearance to spend time with the students.













Fostering Financial Empowerment

Ameris remains dedicated to promoting financial opportunities through strategic partnerships and inclusive banking solutions. By supporting programs like EverFi's financial education for high school students and Wealth Watchers' support for homebuyers, we promote empowerment for individuals and communities.

Additionally, our Opportunity Checking solution provides banking services and financial education for customers who may not qualify for traditional accounts. In 2024, customers enjoyed the benefits of the Opportunity Checking account, helping them to more easily manage their finances and build a stronger financial future.



Caring for Our Culture

In 2024, we continued our investment in Learning and Development programs, including leadership development, emotional intelligence, situational leadership and many other topics.

The Mentor Ameris Program fosters professional development. Mentors are matched with high potential teammates to share their guidance and experiences in this key program to develop talent across all functions of the company.

Caring for our teammates is part of the Ameris culture, which is why we offer competitive benefits, including medical, dental, vision, disability, life insurance, paid time off, 401(k) matching and an employee stock purchase plan. For example, with our competitive 401(k) program, the bank matches 50% of each teammate's elective deferral amount up to the first 8% of their contribution, providing valuable support for retirement.

In addition to our traditional benefits, teammates have options for additional support, including legal assistance and pet insurance. Further, our Employee Assistance Program is offered to teammates and their eligible dependents to help them navigate emotional well-being, legal and financial matters, healthy lifestyles, and work/life transitions.



The Ameris Foundation also committed \$50.000 to the American Red Cross to be used for relief efforts from hurricanes that impacted communities across the Southeast.
