Reporting to the **Technical Services Manager**, the **Planning Engineer** will be responsible for ensuring that production targets are tracked and met in a safe and efficient manner at Battle North Gold – Bateman Gold Project. This position will work a **local 5x2, 8 hour shift schedule** offering a great work/life balance.

Responsibilities

- Prepare short term planning and mine scheduling as required.
- Provide scheduling information to planners, geologists and underground to ensure timely start-up and completion of individual projects.
- Establish planning priorities to achieve production goals.
- Prepare mining conceptual plans and present to operations, geology and engineering team for discussions.
- Schedule mine resources with the Manager of Technical Services.
- Develop an 18 month plan and maintain a rolling 3-6 month plan to ensure targets are met.
- Ensure 3-month production forecasts are compiled and issued in a timely fashion.
- Ensure targets are met; discuss and work with other departments to solve any operational bottlenecks.
- Review schedules and implement necessary contingencies to meet production goals.
- Tour with Underground Supervisors on a regular basis to discuss plans and to involve mining crews; review schedules and communicate concerns at forecast meetings.
- Work in a healthy work environment with full support, cooperation and commitment to satisfy our operation's goal of being accident-free.
- Comply with federal and provincial acts, regulations, and legal requirements.
- Adhere to all company policies and procedures.
- Perform other duties as assigned.

Requirements

- Possess a Bachelor's degree in Mining Engineering from an accredited university and have a minimum of 5 (five) years' experience at underground hard rock mine operations or underground mine development/production projects. Registration as a Professional Engineer or must be eligible for registration within the Province of Ontario.
- Prior knowledge of using Deswick software and spreadsheet programs
- Familiarity with Mine Health and Safety Regulations is required.
- A working knowledge of Datamine and Promine software would be an asset
