PITTSBURGH--(BUSINESS WIRE)--Jul. 1, 2014-- PPG Industries (NYSE:PPG) today announced that its North American architectural coatings business has completed its acquisition of the Masterwork Paint Company, an independent architectural paint distributor headquartered in Pittsburgh. The acquisition of Masterwork's 13-store network throughout Western Pennsylvania, Ohio and New York expands PPG's company-owned stores footprint. Financial terms were not disclosed.

The business produces paints, stains and specialty coatings marketed under well-recognized product lines such as FLOOD(R), GLIDDEN(R), LIQUID NAILS(R), MANOR HALL(R), OLYMPIC(R), PPG Paints, PPG PITTSBURGH PAINTS(R), PPG PORTER PAINTS(R) and SIKKENS(R) brands. Its distribution network includes more than 900 company-owned stores in North America, more than 5,000 independent dealer locations and all major home improvement centers.
